Cancer and Pain Testimony of Wolfgang Späth

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I am Dr Wolfgang Späth. I live in Namibia and am a veterinarian by profession. I was diagnosed with bladder cancer on 10 January 2013 and was operated on by Dr Hans Rabe at the Panorama Hospital in Cape Town on 15 January 2013. Thanks to Dr Rabe's immediate decision to operate on me, the same day he saw me for the first time, he could only scrape out all the cancer from the bladder wall and could save the bladder.

I had a 3 x 3 cm malignant growth in the bladder. A month after surgery I visited the Go Natural shop in Somerset West and I talked to Johan Jacobs. Johan told me that I was patient 263 with cancer and also patient 263 with root canal treatment. He told me about the high correlation between root canal treatment and cancer.

When I was back in Namibia I went to my dentist and got X-rays taken of my mouth. I had three root canal treatments done about 20 to 25 years ago. My dentist had the chart for the correlation of the teeth and the Chinese meridians.

My one tooth with root canal treatment was responsible for the bladder and that is the only tooth for the bladder. The other tooth was responsible for the hip - I had very bad hip pain. The third tooth was responsible for the left knee, and very interesting I had severe knee pain.

After this evaluation I was convinced the three teeth must come out. My dentist was hesitant to pull the three teeth and referred me to a maxillary surgeon. Here I had a problem convincing the surgeon to pull the teeth. In the end I told him if he did not pull the teeth, I would fly to South Africa to find a surgeon who would pull my teeth. Eventually he agreed.

I was booked for surgery at 18h00 on a Friday. I walked in with a very painful hip and sore knee. Since I walked out of the hospital after the three teeth were removed, I never had hip or knee pain again.

This month I had my fifth annual bladder cystoscopy and all looks fine.

I have also changed my diet and lifestyle, but I am convinced that the root canal treated teeth played a big role in my cancer development and pain.
